LAST CIVIL WAR VETERAN DIED IN ATLANTIC SATURDAY

Adnah David Bullock, aged 95, the last surviving Civil War veteran residing in Cass County, died at the home of his son and daughter-in-law, Mr. And Mrs. Wayne Bullock, Saturday morning. He had been in ill health for a year. He was born in Sherburn, New York, April 10, 1846, and served in Co. A., of the 1st New York light artillery. He resided at Waukee, Iowa in 1869 and was married to Ella Fuller, January 16, 1872. They came to Wiota in 1882, later residing in Anita. Following the death of his wife

in 1936, he went to Atlantic to make his home with his son. He was commander of the G. A. R. in Atlantic and a member of the Masonic Lodge in Anita

The funeral services were held on Monday afternoon at 2:30 from the Roland, Peacock & Baxter Funeral Home. The Rev. C. William Bast, pastor of the Congregational church officiated. The American Legion conducted military services and the Masons also exemplified their burial service at the graveside.
